Approval of board & neighborhood minutes (Doug motioned, Claire 2nd; no dissent or abstain).
- Treasurer Report (Doug)
\$1,010 checking, \$38 paypal, \$39,526 savings
- Hance Park (Ryan): Noche en Blanco tickets on sale (Oct 29, 5p – 10p). Hance Park looking for 17.8M from Bond Fund. Joint repairs are ongoing on East side of park. They've decided to resod entire area. Nov 5th is Fall Festival. Sunday, Oct 30th Halloween Pumpkin Carving (reserved area).
- Block Watch (Mark Davis): Securing more block captains.
- Traffic Issues (Ryan): Lynwood St/7th Ave not wide enough for a traffic calming device. Neighborhood mitigation section of Bond could fund. 7th Ave: not adding right turn lanes at Filmore and McKinley. 5th Ave: still problems with visibility @ 5th and Lynwood. 3rd Ave: 3rd/McKinley should have right turn lane. 2nd Ave/McKinley: traffic count does not warrant 4-way stop sign. Alleys: concerns about new development @ Central/McDowell adding cars, trucks, trash down Lynwood. Question related to taking

truck traic down alley, then north to McDowell. Bike Lanes/Signage: Mr Knutson feels RAA complaints due to newness of system... wants to wait and see.

- Development (Ryan): City Center Motel HP Overly Zoning Planning Commission. Hearting Oct 6 @ 6pm. City Council Hearing/Ordinance Adoption Nov 2 @ 2.30pm.
- Downtown Community Reinvestment Fund (Ryan): Looking to use portion of funds to purchase & service trash and recycling cans for northern downtown (Evans and Roosevelt). Claire motion to write letter of support, Doug 2nd. Motion passes. (no dissent/abstain).
- Roses Under The Stairs (Mark Davis): business not complying w/ stipulations. Putting together exhaustive list of non-compliance. Writing letter to business owners. Maybe RAA could host neighborhood mtg and consider committee to help navigate?
