In Oct 2017 met with City to figure how to relocate building. Presented idea to RAA in Oct 2019. Now about 9 months before demo with no clear option to relocate (no lot to move it to). Redevelopment project will commence in June 2023.
- Hance Park: Rick Naimark updated bond issue. \$1.2B in projects by the City. \$109M for Parks recommended by subcommittee. Hance is #4 on the list (had to cut \$64M from budget). Looking towards the importance of balancing spends around the city. Cultural institutions, Vision 0 (cycling), and looking towards equity-based transportation make be focus.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave Closure & Parking (Caroline & David Van Slyke): Needing to work with City on solution for construction crew parking, as well as mediation of parking ticket

enforcement. As construction continues across South Roosevelt streets, wanting to be proactive to mediate the problem. Chris Kowalsky from City (in attendance) will look at some possible remediation plans.
